Footnotes

THE BROTHER SLEW (VEN) broke alertly and tracked behind PAPA CANDELO toward the inside, eased out to the four-path to challenge outside the leader turning for home, cleared off a furlong out, began moving steadily inward under heavy right-hand pressure tightening things up on GRAN OMERO, and held for the decision. GRAN OMERO (VEN) was slow from the gate, hustled up and steadied behind a wall of horses on the first turn, cut the corner rallying into the stretch, loomed along the rail a furlong out, was in tight quarters past the 70-yard marker and checked inside the top one approaching the wire. TURPIN TIME (PAN) was never far back while three wide for six furlongs, lost ground to the leaders shifting to the two-path at the top of the stretch, and stayed on to best the remainder. PAPA CANDELO went to the front out of the gate, showed the way through even splits in the two-path, moved further out coming under attack from the eventual winner turning into the lane, and weakened past the eighth-pole. FIX (PAN) was in some traffic under a firm hold early, stayed close to the top of the lane, but had no final kick in the two-path and faded. JUICE MAN (JAM) steadied along in traffic between horses on the first turn, continued between foes to the far turn, swung five wide for the drive and could not gain. SENOR CONCERTO (PAN) raced four wide on the turns,

and failed to menace. SUPREME SOUL (JAM) was slow to get going three wide to the first turn, and never factored. THIBAUT (MEX) checked along the rail on the first turn, continued to save ground and retreated inside after six furlongs. EL SANTO (MEX) raced in midpack for six furlongs while three wide, moved to the far outside for the drive and tired. DOCTOR SOTELO (VEN) was strung out five wide heading to the first turn, dropped well back after six furlongs and was eased up in the stretch. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE WINNER BY THE RIDER OF GRAN OMER, THERE WAS NO CHANGE TO THE ORDER OF FINISH.
